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Melba Highway into the valley of the Yea River, whose waters fall from the slopes of Mount St Leonard, Tanglefoot and the Victoria Range. It is famous for its rich red-chocolate soil, a haven for bush walkers, game hunters, conservationists, and people of all stripes whose common code is a love of the bush, and a preference for peace and quiet in daily life.

The home comprises 3 bedrooms, 1 bathroom, lounge room and kitchen / dining. The third bedroom offers mezzanine / bunk and self-contained access as a potential separate unit. Additionally, there is a large mudroom, full laundry and secure services room for dry storage attached to the rear of the house. Single garage and carport provide 2 car accommodation. Telephone and mains power connected. It is very functional, and cosy to boot.

The home is of majority double brick construction and thermally very strong. In keeping with the homesteading theme, there is a double chimney in the heart of the home with an open fireplace on one side and combustion stove on the other (electric hot water connected).

Externally there is a concrete-based shed with ample room for storing hardware and machinery. From the back of the block you can enjoy a marvellous view of the Yea River valley.
