The main lounge is open-plan and welcoming, "light and airy" and resonates that feeling of there's no place like home. The Euro wood fireplace and quality insulation keep things comfortable year-round, backed by a reverse-cycle air conditioner.

Outside, the block is equally well set up. A new four-bay shed and a lean-to for firewood add practicality, and the travertine-paved terrace is a great spot to unwind and catch the sun rise and set.

A chicken coop, an orchard (apples, nectarines and apricots + quince and walnuts), separate tool shed, and over 75,000L of water storage.

The land is divided into four paddocks, and the house block is fenced with dog wire to keep pets in, and a low electric wire to keep wombats out.

It's off-grid ready too-with a 6.5kW solar system, 4.5kW of battery storage, and internet via satellite or the fixed wireless tower installed on the hill (Hyperwave).

Wildlife is part of the daily rhythm-kangaroos, wombats, echidnas, and deer regularly wander through.

The birdlife is a real highlight, from the chatter of rosellas and king parrots to the whoosh of wedge-tailed eagles overhead.

In the mornings, the garden fills with birdsong from wrens, cockatoos, kookaburras, and more.

Located just 50 minutes from Lilydale and under 90 minutes from Melbourne, it's a peaceful retreat that's still within easy reach.

Nearby, you've got the new "The General" café/restaurant in Strath Creek, "Boots and Bobs" at the Flowerdale community hall (Thursday–Sunday), and of course, the iconic Flowerdale pub.
